Program: The Community Impacts Division at JFS is dedicated to developing an

infrastructure and support system for measuring impact at all levels. The Division has begun working closely in partnership with several San Diego County stakeholders to promote the Linda Vista Kindergarten Readiness

Network (LVKRN).

LVKRN brings together nonprofits, health providers, schools, government agencies, businesses, and community collaborators to address the array of educational, emotional, economic, and health-related needs of Linda Vista children and families in order to increase rates of kindergarten readiness and

overall academic success.

Goal of Position: This department is searching for a volunteer who is passionate about language,

communication, and outreach. The Vietnamese Linguistic Specialist will assist the Community Impacts Division in reaching Vietnamese-speaking families in Linda Vista. This will be achieved by translating written materials (including workshop materials, handouts, flyers and newsletters) in an enticing,

approachable, and culturally appropriate manner.
