

Parkinson's Foundation Team Training Scholarship Opportunities

On a case-by-case basis, a donor or sponsor will provide funding in the form of Team Training registration scholarships and/or travel scholarships. These scholarships are specific to each individualized team training program and may change from one training to another, depending on the sponsor's request. The information listed below is current and at this time, there are no other scholarships available other than below:

Team Training scholarships currently available:

1. Heartland Chapter Service Area (**Kansas, Missouri, Iowa and Nebraska**)

This scholarship opportunity was made possible through generous donations made in honor of Jane Ann Gorsky, former employee of the Parkinson's Foundation in the Heartland area who retired in 2019. Inspired by the team training's mission to improve the quality of care for people with Parkinson's and their families, this donation was specifically dedicated to creating a scholarship opportunity for healthcare professionals in the Heartland region.

Requirements: This scholarship is specifically for teams of 3 or more individuals (must represent at least 2 different disciplines from the same facility) only within the states of Kansas, Western Missouri, Iowa and Nebraska. (All 3 team members must attend the same training. Team member names and disciplines are required on the scholarship form.)

What's covered:

Team registration fees: (\$475 per person) will be waived.

For in-person trainings: Hotel and ground transportation **up to \$1,000 per person**, reimbursed by receipt after the training has been completed.

For virtual trainings: If the team would prefer to rent an office space, hotel space, etc. to be used for the virtual training dates, or to hold team meetings after completing modules, the space or hotel rental and ground transportation will be covered **up to \$1,000 per person**, reimbursed by receipt after the training has been completed.

To apply for this scholarship:

1. All 3 team members must be either licensed in one of the listed disciplines, an MD fellow, or a full-time student which has not been previously credentialed in their field of study. One team member could also be a program director, manager, or facility coordinator if they are directing patient care and attending with the team.
2. All 3 team members must be currently working with the Parkinson's population.
3. All 3 team members must first register to attend the same training together and receive the acceptance letter.

4. Once all 3 are accepted, only ONE person from the team must fill out the scholarship application and provide the names, credentials, email and phone information for all 3 team members.
