About Us - Founded in 2001, the National Scleroderma Foundation Rocky Mountain Chapter (NSFRMC) is dedicated to serving the needs of the scleroderma community. Our primary goal is to raise funds and awareness for our three-fold mission of **support**, **education** and **research**. The chapter currently serves scleroderma patients, their families and caregivers in Colorado, Wyoming, Utah, and New Mexico.

About Scleroderma - Scleroderma is a chronic, often progressive, autoimmune disease in which the immune system attacks its own body. Scleroderma means "hard skin". It causes thickening and tightening of the skin. It can also cause serious damage to internal organs including the lungs, heart, kidneys, esophagus and gastrointestinal tract. Medications and treatments may help with certain symptoms, but there is no cure. The disease affects 300,000 people in the U.S., with 7,000 new cases diagnosed each year. Scleroderma affects women 3-4 times more often than men and may significantly reduce average life span for both by more than 20 years.

Our Events – The NSFRMC provides many opportunities for the Rocky Mountain scleroderma community to come together. We host seven recurring support groups in the region each year. Additionally we host several patient education events where attendees learn from the region's scleroderma experts.

In June of 2022, we will host Stepping Out to Cure Scleroderma walks in Colorado and Utah. Our Denver walk attracts 350 walkers annually and our Northern Colorado walk almost 125 walkers annually. The Utah event is new in 2022.

Our 6th Food Fight for Scleroderma will be held in October of 2022. This premier philanthropic event offers food lovers and foundation supporters the opportunity to mingle with distinguished chefs and bartenders from Denver's most beloved establishments. Guests enjoy an evening filled with delectable bites and innovative cocktails before casting their vote for best savory, sweet, and sip.
